Bands (or solo artists) will be required to pay a *non-refundable* £10 entry fee, prior to the competition (which will be used in a non-profit basis in the running of Nebula Festival 2019). This fee must be paid into the GoFundMe page with appropriate evidence of payment.

Performers must be at the venue on-time *and* ready for their sound check, without exception.

Performers must respect the venue staff and facilities. This includes any and all equipment provided for the performance by Nebula Festival. Performers will be liable for any damage they cause.

The performer must provide any and all technical and rider information to NebulaFestival@gmail.com by Monday 18th March 2019.

Nebula Festival reserves the right to make changes to the competition schedule. It is the responsibility of the performer(s) to monitor their given contact emails and telephone for any changes made.

All members of the winning band will be required to sign an additional performer contract prior to their performance at Nebula Festival, and as a collective, will be required to submit an appropriate invoice by Friday 19th of April, as well as a completed University of Lincoln Supplier form (this form will be supplied by Nebula Festival). Performers will allow up to 30 days from their performance on Saturday 4th April for payment to be received. Nebula Festival reserves to right to withhold payment if the terms of the performer contract are not met by the artist.
